ABOUT WALES AIR AMBULANCE CHARITY

At the heart of everything that we do are our people. Over the last 24 years, our charity has grown from a single aircraft operation to the largest air ambulance service in the UK.

Our charity is delivered via a unique Third Sector and Public Sector partnership. The Emergency Medical Retrieval and Transfer Service (EMRTS) supplies highly skilled NHS consultants and critical care practitioners who work on board the Charity's vehicles.

Through the introduction of EMRTS, we became consultant-led and one of the most advanced air ambulance services in Europe. The scheme is committed not only to providing the most advanced pre-hospital care in Wales but also to upskilling and attracting doctors and CCPs to live and work in Wales.

As a pan-Wales service, the dedicated crews will travel the length and breadth of the country to deliver emergency lifesaving care.

The highly skilled crew on board can carry out medical procedures which would usually only be available within a hospital setting.

Our patients are at the heart of everything we do, and we want to improve the lives of our patients by becoming a world leader in advanced, time-critical care.

We are entirely funded by charitable donations and rely on your support to raise £13 million every year to keep our four helicopters in the air and fleet of rapid response vehicles on the road across Wales.
